

Requirements to the transportation of fresh fruit, vegetables, and plants (bulbs, cut and potted plants)

Terms and definitions:

Temperature sensor means a standard device installed into the cargo compartment of a vehicle/container to monitor the temperature of the supply-and-exhaust air

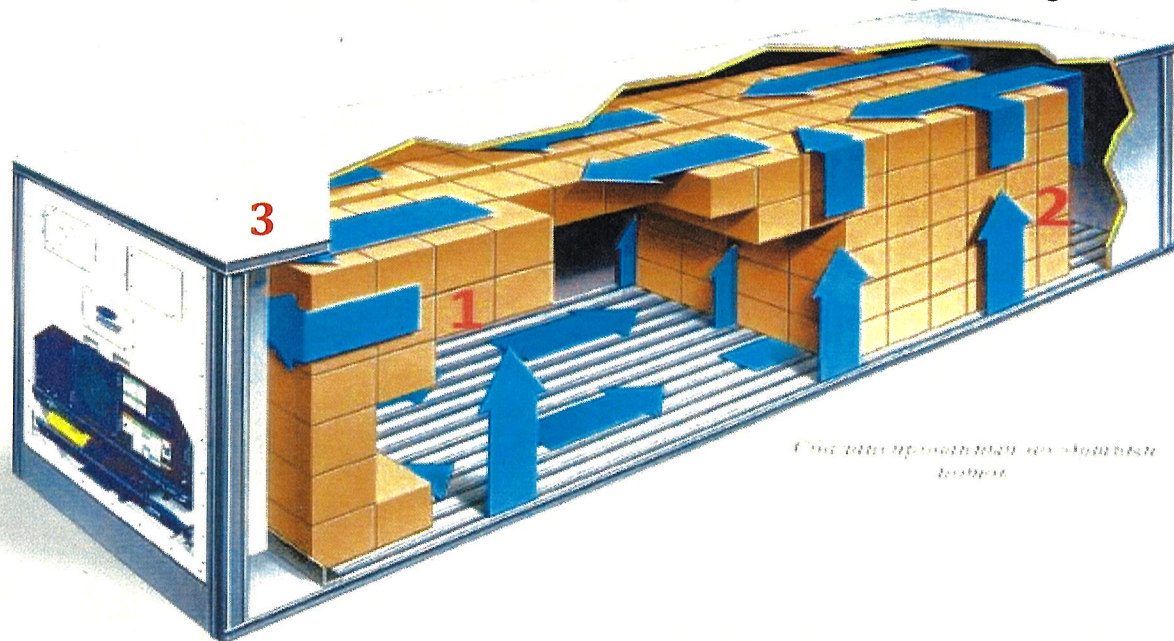
Thermologger means a mobile device for monitoring the temperature inside a cargo compartment of a vehicle/container placed in/on the shipping container with goods

Transportation shall be carried out in accordance with Article 17 of CU TR 021/2011 On Food Safety unless otherwise provided by the Technical Regulations for certain types of goods.

In order to ensure temperature control during transportation, 1–3 thermologgers shall be installed and accompanying documents shall contain appropriate marks:

1. **Installation of thermologgers.**

Thermologgers shall be installed inside the cargo compartment/container as per the diagram



Thermologger 1 (Point 1) shall be installed in the second box on top of the pallet located at the beginning of the vehicle (next to the refrigeration system) and shall not be in contact with the walls of the cargo compartment of the vehicle/container. The location of the thermologger shall be marked with warning sheets of at least A4 size securely attached to four sides of the pallet or with other warning label/marking that enables to unmistakably determine the location of the thermologger.

Thermologger 2 (Point 2) shall be placed in the middle of the last row of boxes near the doors of the cargo compartment of the vehicle/container. The location of the thermologger shall be marked as per the above clause.

Further information: if there are 3 lines of pallets in the cargo compartment/container, the pallet with the temperature sensor shall be placed in the middle.

Thermologger 3 (Point 3) (if any) shall be installed on the top row of boxes that are located closest to the refrigeration system (not covered with the goods) and marked as per the above clause.

If there is only one thermologger in the cargo compartment/container, it shall be installed at Point 1 or 2.

2. Marks in accompanying documents.

The Supplier (Forwarder) shall without fail provide the following data together with the packing list: serial numbers of thermologgers, numbers of pallets with thermologgers, temperature set for transportation, air exchange (if necessary).

The packing list shall contain the following minimum set of information:

- vehicle number,


- number of boxes/pallets classified by size, brand, grade and manufacturer/graver/packager.

If the transferred documents have no information on thermologgers and/or thermologgers are not installed as per Clause 1, Lenta LLC shall have the right to reject the delivery or make a claim within 48 hours from the goods unloading (as temperature control during transportation cannot be confirmed).

Recommended thermologger models: Log tag, TempTale 4 USB, BT-9 (Xsense) or any other models that can be read via USB.
